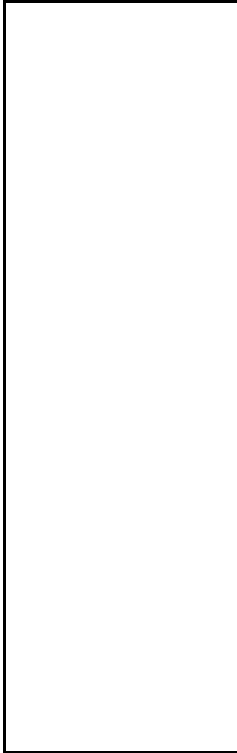

Hours RV Overnight will be available: **Wednesday, May, 15 - 3:00 P.M. - 10:00 P.M., Thursday, Friday, 6:00 A.M. - 8:00 A.M. and 3:00 P.M. - 10:00 P.M.; Saturday 6:00 A.M. - 7:00 A.M. and after Best in Show - 10:00 P.M.; Sunday, 6:00 A.M. - 7:00 A.M.** All vehicles must be off the grounds one hour after Best in Show - **Sunday**.

**OVERNIGHT & DAY OF SHOW PARKING ARE PRIVILEGES OF THE SOLANO COUNTY FAIRGROUNDS AND COYOTE HILLS KENNEL CLUB, INC. The Fairgrounds or Club takes **NO** responsibility for vehicles towed and/or ticketed in violation of parking laws or regulations & subject to actions of regulatory officers or agents. Vehicles illegally parked will be towed and/or ticketed at the owner's expense. The fire department has forbidden any vehicles in fire lanes or any unauthorized area. **PARKING SPACES WILL BE PRE-ASSIGNED.** PEOPLE WISHING TO PARK TOGETHER MUST SEND IN THEIR RESERVATIONS TOGETHER, however there is no guarantee that we can accommodate all requests.

**COST: \$45.00 PER NIGHT/PER SPACE.** Spaces are 22' x 40'. Vehicles over 40' total length or vehicles with a slide out that will not fit in a 22' x 40' space will need to buy two spaces. If your entire package will not fit in a 22' x 40' space, you will need to buy additional space. **Trailers and tow units may be required to be unhitched.** Vehicles over 40' in length will be accompanied only where possible. Tagalong vehicle is \$50.00 flat fee, & must fit into assigned space. (A TAG is a vehicle that arrives with an RV or a vehicle that will be parked in the same space as the RV- everything must fit.)

VERY LIMITED HANDICAPPED PARKING will be available; IT MAY NOT NECESSARILY BE CLOSE TO THE RINGS. A suitable access will be provided. **Please provide proof of your valid handicapped license with your RV Overnight reservation form.** NO NON-RESERVED RV HANDICAPPED WILL BE AVAILABLE. Handicapped RV parking does not guarantee electric.

**NO ONE is guaranteed that your parking space will have electricity. ELECTRIC CANNOT BE RESERVED, ASSIGNED, REQUESTED, SAVED AND/OR GUARANTEED.** Please be prepared if you do not have electricity. There will be NO "Piggy Backing" into another rig who is plugged into the Fairgrounds electricity. **NO CORDS** across any sidewalks, walkways, roadways, or fire lanes. Any violators will be disconnected immediately & MAY be subject to Events Committee Charges. **Please remember electricity, IF available, is extremely limited, everyone WILL NOT have, get, find, be guaranteed and/or should expect electricity, no matter what time you arrive and/or where you are parked. There is no guarantee that your parking space will have access to electricity. Payment of RV overnight parking fee does not guarantee electricity.**

No Vehicle traffic in show limits during judging hours.

No Visitors may drive their cars into the RV overnight area. They must park in the day of show lot and walk inside.

All vehicles must be completely self-contained. **NO** discharge of grey water or sanitary tanks allowed.

All RVs using a generator must have a proper exhaust pipe venting away from the dogs & people - Quiet time: **11:00 P.M. - 6:00 A.M. No generators!**

No more than two vehicles with a total length of 40' per space, this includes tagalong/tow vehicle.

All vehicles will be parked in the same direction in the rows and/or side-by-side and/or head to tail. **STRICTLY ENFORCED.**

## Notice To Exhibitors

1. Conditional, telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of Entry Forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries without fees are not acceptable. Fees must accompany entries.
2. Post dated checks and returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Club will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor(s) may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.
3. **PLEASE TYPEWRITE or NEATLY PRINT** all entries. Use black or blue ink as entries will be photocopied. DO NOT use pencil or colored ink to write entries.
4. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Changes are not acceptable by telephone. Email or faxed changes are allowed.
5. **ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS** — Owners alone are responsible for the correctness of entries, or for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which the dog is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date and time. Due to cost of processing, no refunds less than \$4.00 will be made.
6. **ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event's Show Committee. If, because of riots, wars, civil disturbances, fire, Act of God, strikes, national emergencies, health emergencies, extreme weather conditions (including but not limited to extreme heat, floods, hurricanes, lightning, or earthquakes), or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry fees will be made. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fees will be made.
7. **CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME** will be sent after the closing date to the mailing address on the Official AKC Entry Form. In addition, it will be emailed electronically to the email address if provided. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule within seven days of the show, please notify the Show Secretary.
8. **DECLINATION OF ENTRIES:** The Club may decline any entry for cause, and may refuse to receive, or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other causes, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Club or any official thereof.
9. **PLEASE NOTE:** Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Sec 6)
10. **DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
11. **DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class.
12. **NO DOGS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW AREA** except those regularly entered in the show. There will be NO SPACE for unentered dogs at this show. All dogs shall be kept on leash or confined, except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
13. **ALL AWARDS WILL BE MADE** in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog and that person shall be considered the owner or the agent. All claims for trophies must be made in the judging ring before the completion of judging, and the Show Secretary should be advised at once of any discrepancy. The showing club and its officials disclaim any liability for any awards not claimed on the day of the show.
14. The Club will take every precaution for the safety of dogs exhibited, but it is understood that the Doberman Pinscher Club of Northern California will not be responsible for loss. The welfare of the exhibitor's child is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. Please secure proper crates or means to confine dogs for the welfare of all concerned.
15. **OBEDIENCE CLASS TRANSFERS** will be allowed in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. The Show Secretary must be notified in writing no later than 30 minutes prior to judging.
16. **BITCHES IN SEASON** are not allowed to compete in Obedience classes. If a female is withdrawn from competition for coming into season and the Event Secretary is notified no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class, then the club will refund the entry fee. **A processing fee of \$10.00 per entry will be retained.** The club may require a veterinarian's letter as documentation.

Winners of the Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch Classes may also compete in the Best of Breed Competition, provided that they are undefeated in any Regular Class at this show.

**BEST PUPPY IN REGULAR CLASSES** – Chosen from the winners of Puppy Dogs 6-9, Puppy Dogs 9-12, Puppy Bitches 6-9, and Puppy Bitches 9-12. If a puppy entrant is chosen Best of Breed or Best of Winners, then it is automatically awarded Best Puppy.

**BEST VETERAN** – Chosen from the winners of the Veterans Dog and Veterans Bitch classes.
